BRISTOL BREAST CARE CENTRE

In 2013, The Southmead Breast Care Centre was expanded to include the United Hospitals Bristol staff and patients. The clinical teams are now working together to create a Centre of Excellence for breast care in Bristol and the surrounding areas.

The Breast-cancer Unit Support Trust was established in 1991 by three patients who had been treated for breast cancer at Frenchay Hospital. They were alerted to the pressing need for specialist equipment, unavailable on the NHS, to provide quicker and better diagnosis of breast abnormalities and decided to set up a group to raise money for this. The charity's prime aim is still to raise funds to purchase the latest technology for the benefit of patients.

Today the five ultrasound scanners used by doctors in the clinics testify to the fundraising success of **BUST**. See our website www.bustbristol.co.uk to see what else we have bought. Since its inception **BUST** has raised more than £1,000,000 and every penny has been spent supporting patient care. As well as providing state-of-the-art scanners, **BUST** is also contributing to pioneering surgery and treatments.
